- We served and ministered to men, women, youth and pastors in diverse settings including: revival meetings, men's conference, 2 pastor's conferences, as well as sharing in different churches within Lagos and Ogun States.
- The churches in Nigeria are growing rapidly. They are leading the movement and spread of the gospel in Africa by doing evangelism everywhere they go, having amazing worship, powerful prayer meetings, and revival meetings with hundreds of thousands in attendance.
- However, there's still a great need for solid biblical teaching and training. Many pastors have not had opportunity to attend Bible College or Seminary, or have had no solid training at all. There are also churches and pastors that are struggling greatly due to the harsh economic and financial situation in the country. Some are even struggling to the extent that they can't afford any kind of medical care or a simple Doctor's visit. This is why we provided a free medical check-up for the pastors and christian leaders at the conference.
- By God's grace we were also able to give out simple gifts to struggling pastors and churches. We gave them various gifts, including umbrellas, shoes, clothing, t-shirts, hats, suits, teaching materials, educational CD's and books.
- We thank God for all He did, and for how the Lord used the **Hallomai Team** to bring God's hope, love and encouragement. Many doors have opened for similar conferences in other parts of the country.
